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nitrous oxide sedation commonly known as laughing gas is one of the most widely used methods for managing anxiety and discomfort in dental practice it provides a safe quick onset and easily titratable form of conscious sedation allowing patients especially children to remain relaxed yet responsive during treatment its rapid recovery and minimal side effects make it an ideal choice for routine pediatric and adult dental procedures

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
